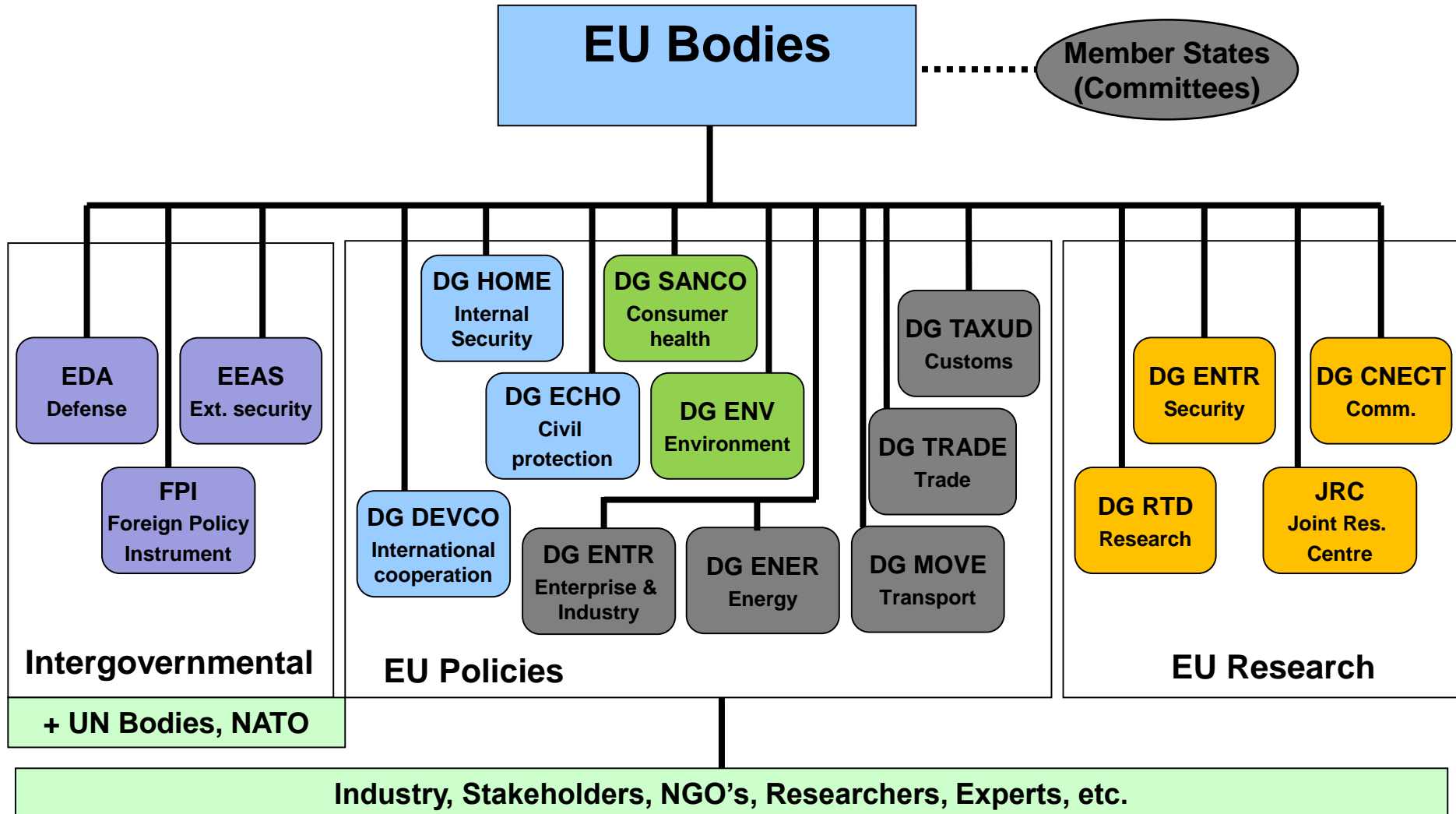

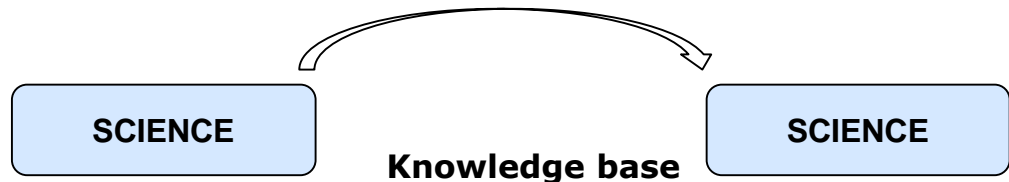




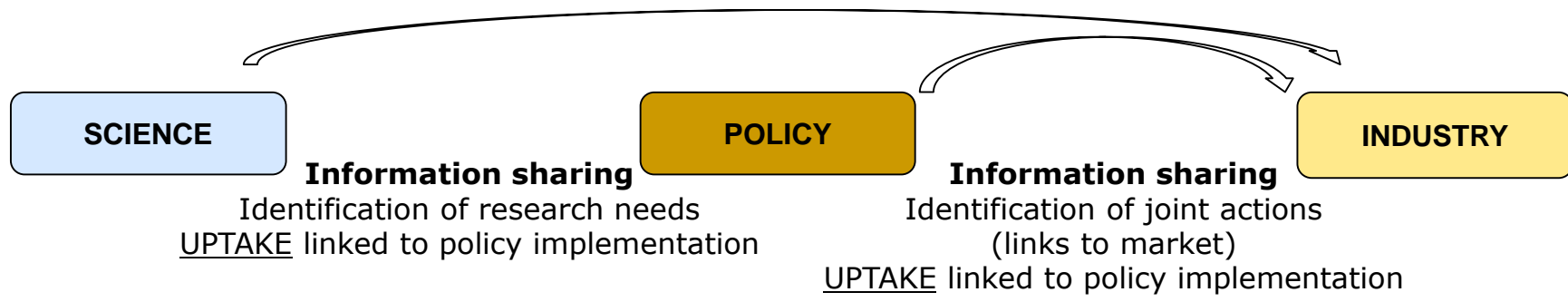
# Fighting fragmentation: Towards Science-Policy- Industry interfacing?

# Fighting fragmentation: Towards Science-Policy- Industry interfacing?

## **WHAT DO WE WANT?**

- Fight fragmentation: identify pieces of the "puzzle" and work on it!
- Share information: raise awareness
- Transfer information: at relevant levels, from international to local
- Demonstrate applicability: with end users
- Support access to market

## **SIMPLE COOKING RECIPES**

- Relying on existing networks: need info on Committees, think tanks, projects which might have an interfacing role
- Ensuring regular information sharing events, back-to-back to possible policy events, preferably in Brussels!
- Compilation of relevant (policy & research) information on annual basis

## **STEPS AHEAD**

- Mapping of projects related to identified policy hooks: preparing the ground for H2020
- Building a culture of exchange, "door opening" from research to policy and policy to research but in a concerted way: formatting of the information, avoiding multiple meetings in exotic places
- Possible links among research / demonstration projects with training/capacity-building projects and possibly with national initiatives
- Identification of most promising tools/technologies, support to access to market
